

UK DX RTTY CONTEST CABRILLO LOG FORMAT

THE CONTEST COMMITTEE ACCEPTS LOGS IN THE CABRILLO FORMAT ONLY

CABRILLO HEADER

START-OF-LOG: Version number. It must be the first line of the log submission. The current Cabrillo version number is 2.0.

END-OF-LOG: It must be the last line of the log submission.

CALLSIGN: The callsign used during the contest.

CATEGORY: Entrant's category. It must be **SOAB-HP** (single operator, all bands, and high power), **SOAB-LP** (single operator, all bands, and low power) or **MOST-HP** (multi operator, all bands, single transmitter, and high power).

CLAIMED-SCORE: The claimed score of the log submission, in integer form such as 107315 or 19113 or 18.

CLUB: Name of the radio club with which the score should be aggregated.

CONTEST: The contest name must be **UK-DX-RTTY**.

CREATED-BY: Name and version of the logging program used to create the Cabrillo file, such as N1MM LOGGER V3.0.230.

NAME: Entrant's name.

ADDRESS: Entrant's address. ADDRESS lines may appear multiple times with different data, as shown below. Please limit the number of ADDRESS lines to a total count of four so that the name and address may be fit onto a standard mailing label.

OPERATORS: A space delimited list of operator callsign(s). Multi operator station must list all operators.

SOAPBOX: Entrant's comments. SOAPBOX lines may appear multiple times with different data.

FREQ: It must be integer frequency in kHz, if frequency is not known then 28000, 21000, 14000, 7000 or 3500.

MO: RY

DATE: UTC date in YYYY-MM-DD format.

TIME: UTC time in NNNN format.

CALLSIGN: Callsign.

RST: RST.

NUM: Sent and received number for exchange. UK stations - UK Area Code, DX stations - QSO number, starting 001.

CABRILLO FILE NAME

Name your Cabrillo file as your callsign (for example - gm4agg.cbr or gm4agg.log). And if your callsign includes "/" (slash), you have to replace it with "-" (dash) in order to avoid an error (for example - gm4agg-p.cbr means GM4AGG/P). This is very important for quick and smooth check processing.
